

# SUPERIOR COURT OF CALIFORNIA, COUNTY OF SUTTER

## 2026 FELONY BAIL SCHEDULE

---

### **INTRODUCTION:**

Sutter County Superior Court has adopted the attached bail schedule pursuant to Penal Code (PC) §1269b. The purpose of the bail schedule is to fix an amount upon which a person who is arrested without a warrant may be released from custody prior to appearance in court. At and after a defendant's first appearance, pursuant to §1269b(b) PC, the amount of bail, if any is allowed, shall lie with the sound discretion of the judicial officer before whom the defendant appeared, and may be greater or less than the amount set for in this schedule, subject to §1275 PC. This schedule may also be used by the magistrate in fixing bail pursuant to §815a at the time an arrest warrant is issued, the amount of which lies with the sound discretion of the magistrate.

### **BAIL AMOUNT FOR OFFENSES NOT LISTED IN THE BAIL SCHEDULE:**

For all offenses and enhancements for which no presumptive bail is specified in this schedule, the presumptive bail shall be set according to state prison top term potential for the offense plus the enhancement:

Top Term – 3 Years: 15,000	Top Term – 9 Years: 45,000
Top Term – 4 Years: 20,000	Top Term – 10 Years: 50,000
Top Term – 5 Years: 25,000	Top Term – 11 Years: 55,000
Top Term – 6 Years: 30,000	Top Term – 12 Years: 60,000
Top Term – 7 Years: 35,000	Top Term – 16 Years: 100,000
Top Term – 8 Years: 40,000	All life sentence except 187: 1,000,000

### **VIOLATIONS OF PROBATION / PAROLE / MANDATORY SUPERVISION / POST-RELEASE COMMUNITY SUPERVISION:**

Felony: NO BAIL (at arraignment on Judge's order, as required by law)

Misdemeanor: 11,000 (at arraignment, O/R release or as otherwise ordered by Judge)

### **ATTEMPTS / CONSPIRACIES / SOLICITATIONS:**

The bail shall be the same as the target offense.

### **MULTIPLE OFFENSES:**

- Normal rule: The Court will utilize the highest amount for the most serious offense charged, including applicable amounts for enhancements and prior convictions. The Court shall consider the applicability of §654 PC.
- Multiple Victims: The Court shall set bail on the most serious offense against each victim.
- Multiple crimes / separate occasions: The Court will utilize the highest amount for each occasion.
- Sex crimes: Where the defendant is charged with commission of more than one sex crime, if the crime can be punished consecutively, bail shall be stacked.

**PENAL CODE §1270.1: HEARING REQUIRED (Violent / Serious / Designated Offenses)**

§1270.1 PC prohibits the release of an arrestee on bail in an amount other than that set forth in this bail schedule prior to a hearing in open court for:

- Violent felonies as defined in §667.5(c) PC (not include §460(a) PC);
- Serious felonies as defined in §1192.7(c) PC (including those listed in §1192.8 PC);
- Violations of §136.1(c), 243(e)(1), 262, 273.5, 422 (as a felony), and 646.9 PC;
- Violations of §273.6 PC if the detained person made threats to kill or harm, has engaged in violence against or has gone to the residence or workplace of the protected party.

**PERSONS NOT ENTITLED TO RELEASE ON BAIL:** (Cal. Const. Art. I §12; §1270.5 PC)

Capital crimes when the facts are evident, or the presumption is great.

Felony offenses involving acts of violence on another person, or felony sexual assault on another person, when the facts are evident or the presumption great and the Court finds based upon clear and convincing evidence that there is a substantial likelihood the person's release would result in great bodily harm to others, or;

Felony offenses when the facts are evident or the presumption great and the Court finds based on clear and convincing evidence that the person has threatened another with great bodily harm and that there is a substantial likelihood that the person would carry out the threat if released.

**BAIL DEVIATIONS / SOURCE OF FUNDS:**

Persons entitled to request a deviation of bail schedule (§1269c PC) or law enforcement officers making a source of funds request (§1275.1 PC) may use the search warrant call list to contact a magistrate.
